## DISC GOLF & DDC CHAMPIONSHIPS JULY 25-27, 2003 Limited Entry • PDGA XB TIER

**GENERAL INFORMATION** (as of 5/15/03)- Thanks to Disc Golf World News for wonderful coverage of the Kiss The Sky course and event. The field is filling fast so get your entries in soon to reserve your spot. The highest disc golf course in the World at the top of Aspen Mountain. At an elevation of almost two miles high; this will be the most demanding disc golf course that you will ever play. From Denver you take I-70 West to Glenwood Springs (About 2 1/2 hours), then go South on Highway 82 into downtown Aspen. It's best to park in the Rio Grande parking garage and walk to the gondola. You will ride the Silver Queen Gondola approximately 15 minutes to the top of Aspen Mountain. The lift will take you from a base elevation of nearly 8,000 feet to an elevation of 11,212 feet. From there you will tee off and play a very spectacular round of golf.

This will be the 9th annual event held at this Disc Golf Course. Make your camping and hotel reservations early. Check with Snowmass area accommodations as well as Aspen. Often they are less expensive and mostly they are more available. **GOLF** - The event will be a minimum of 40 holes of disc golf. We are restricted to lift time so the time to play is short and the course is long. This is a sanctioned PDGA event, and all rules of the PDGA apply. Play will be similar to 2002, but as of this time final course design has not been determined. Be prepared to load the gondola by 9:00am on Saturday and Sunday. Doubles best disc will be played on Friday, July 25th. Tee off is generally set for 1pm. Doubles is played at the same time as DDC, so if you plan on playing DDC you will not be able to make Doubles on Friday. It is likely that there will be a doubles or additional round of golf on Monday at Snowmass for those that just can't get enough.

**DOUBLE DISC COURT-** Double Disc Court will be held on Friday, July 25 th only. Play will begin by 11am so make your travel plans accordingly. We will limit the field to 18 DDC teams. The final pool seedings will be determined on the morning of July 25th when all entries are in. There will be a special registration fee of \$45 for those not participating in the golf portion of the tournament. You will not receive lift tickets, lunches or golf discs in this registration package. Fields will be Wagner park OR Rio Grande Park depending on availability.

**REGISTRATION PACKAGE** -This event will feature a nice players package. As in the past, we feel that each player should be rewarded just for attending. Our package will feature a number of commemorative items, two days of lunches and lift tickets for three days.

**PRIZES** - Prizes and cash will be awarded for the top 40% of each division with four or more participants. Prizes will include: Commemorative Discs, Hats & T-shirts for the event, Gift Certificates and more. Trophies will be awarded to the winner of each division with 4 or more entries. Pro divisions will receive cash payouts.
